## SOME TIPS TO REMEMBER WHILE LETTERING ...

A comic book page reads from left-to-right, then down. In a panel, characters should speak in order from left-to-right. This helps guide the reader through the page.

When lettering, it helps to use capital letters.

## The lettering process:

Find your best space on the panel - try not to obscure characters or anything important.

Start with a pencil:

Line your space.

Write in the words, trying to keep a roughly oval shape.

Then, and only then, draw in your balloon.

Draw a 'tail' that connects the balloon to your character's mouth.

Ink it.

Lightly rub out the pencil lines.

Gaze proudly on your neat, legible, masterpiece.
