WORKSHOP 5 - STORY TO SCRIPT

Tips for writing your script:

The golden rule: your script should be clear, and easy to read. It's a set of instructions for the artist to tell your story. That is all.

First:

Describe what is in the panel, including all the characters, where they are, and what they are doing. Don't forget emotions - are they happy, sad?

Second:

Include any and all dialogue, and captions. Regardless of where they appear in the panel, they go last in the script.

Then, onto the next panel!

There is no need to be too detailed. Just put in what you need to put in.
